# Removing the Sprenger – Leman prism

- Do not touch the prism on any part of the binoculars' body, as you can destroy the prism!
- It is an awkward movement: keep the prism knife-edge away from touching the binoculars' body.
- Let's see how it is doing the expert – Terry Vacani









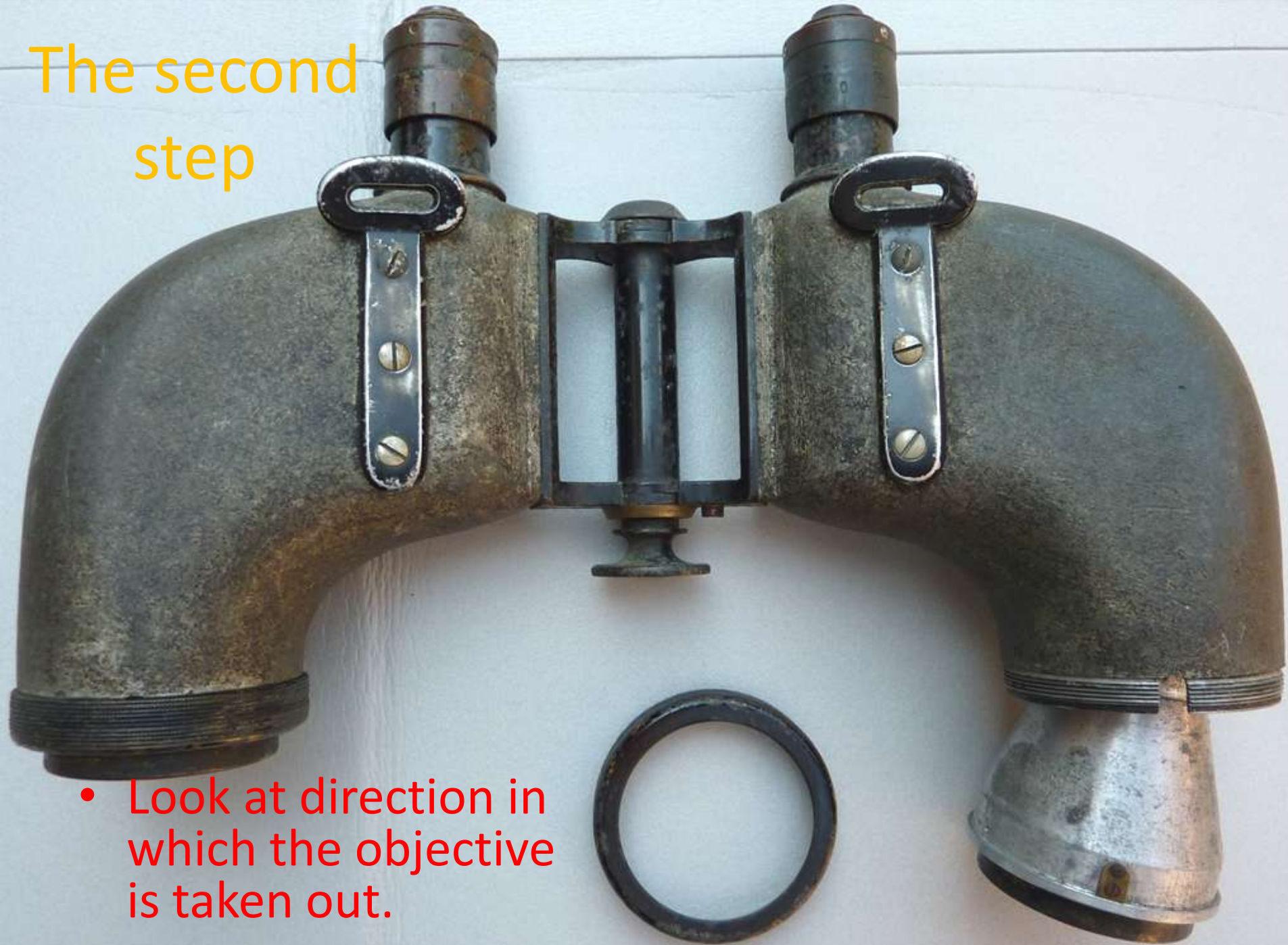
Let's look at every one step
